For the Manufacture and Supply of Screw Lifting Jacks ("Tender")

General Terms and Conditions

Israel Railways Ltd. (the "**ISR**"), in accordance with its obligations under the Israeli Mandatory Tender Laws, its implementing regulations and the International Agreement on Government Procurement, wishes to obtain proposals from participants (the "**Bidder/s**") for:

The manufacture and supply of Screw Lifting Jacks, (hereinafter the "**Devices**" or "**Jacks**"), all in accordance with and subject to the terms specified in this General Terms and Conditions and the accompanying Tender Documents.

The Winning Bidder shall enter into a framework agreement with ISR (the "**Agreement**"), pursuant to which ISR shall be entitled (but not obligated) to order the Devices mentioned above in any quantity during the Agreement Period and as defined in the Agreement. ISR shall have the sole discretion and shall have no obligation to order any quantity thereof.

All capitalized terms used herein that are not defined, shall have the meanings assigned to them in, or by reference, in the Agreement.

1. Pre-requisites for Participation in the Tender (the "Pre-requisites"):

- 1.1. The Bidder must be the Manufacturer, designer and Supplier of the proposed Devices.
- 1.2. The Bidder has manufactured, designed and supplied, commencing from 2020 and up to the Final Submission Date, at least ninety-six (96) single units of Jacks, which were supplied as sets of 4- 24 units, for the heavy railway industry.
- 1.3. The Bidder must be certified for a Quality Control system in accordance with ISO 9001. Such Certification shall remain valid at all times, including the Proposal Validity Period and the Agreement Period, if applicable.

2. Proof of Compliance with the Pre-requisites

Bidder shall prove full compliance with the Pre-requisites specified in Section 1 above, by submitting to ISR all the details, documents and confirmations required under the provisions of the Pre-requisites which shall include, *inter alia*, the following:

- 2.1. For proof of compliance with Section 1.1 above, the Bidder shall submit a signed and completed Manufacturer and Supplier Declaration, in the form attached hereto as **Appendix E**.
- 2.2. For proof of compliance with Sections 1.2 above, the Bidder shall submit a signed and completed Experience and Reference List, in the form attached hereto as **Appendix D**, evidencing that the Bidder has manufactured, designed and supplied, commencing from 2020 and up to the Final Submission Date, at least ninety-six (96) single units of Jacks, which were supplied as sets of 4- 24 units, for the heavy railway industry.
- 2.3. For proof of compliance with Section 1.3 above, the Bidder shall submit a copy of a valid certificate of the manufacturing plant for a quality control system in accordance with ISO 9001 standards.
- 2.4. Bidder shall submit additional proof such as manufacturing reports, supply reports, documentation and all other additional proofs such as clients' reference letters and other relevant documentation that will prove that Bidder meets all the requirements outlined in Section 1 above.
- 2.5. Notwithstanding the aforesaid, ISR reserves its right, at its sole discretion, not to disqualify Proposals which do not contain all the documents and certificates necessary to prove its compliance with the Pre-requisites. Furthermore, ISR shall have the right, at its sole discretion, to accept slight deviations from certain requirements in the technical specification attached hereto as **Appendix A** (the "**Technical Specifications**").
- 2.6. ISR shall have the right, at its sole discretion, to request from any of the Bidders, details and/or approvals and/or tests and/or recommendations and/or certificates and/or additional documentation, required in order to allow ISR a full and complete review of the aforementioned. For the avoidance of any doubt, it is hereby clarified that ISR is not committed to approach any of the Bidders in request for clarifications.
- 2.7. Bidder shall undertake to maintain its compliance with the Pre-requisites specified in Section 1 above at all times, up to and including the Proposal Validity Period, as set forth in Section 12 below.

3. **Technical Requirements**

The proposed Devices must comply with the requirements and terms included in the Technical Specifications attached hereto as **Appendix A**. Further to the aforementioned, ISR, at its sole discretion, shall have the right to accept slight deviations from certain requirements in the Technical Specification.

4. **Governing Agreement**

The manufacture, design and supply of the Devices, including, but not limited to, the price, terms of payment, scope of liability, responsibility and all other general and legal terms for the engagement with the Bidder, shall be governed by the terms and conditions of the Agreement attached hereto as **Appendix C**. The Agreement and the Appendices attached thereto constitute an inseparable part of this Tender. Each Bidder agrees to be bound by the Agreement in the event that it is chosen as the Winning Bidder. Once the Winning Bidder is chosen and the Agreement executed, the provisions of the Agreement shall take precedence over the provisions of this Tender in the event of a contradiction between the Agreement and this Tender.

5. **Purchase Order**

ISR intends to issue purchase orders for the Devices (the "**Purchase Order**") throughout the Agreement Period. The Purchase Orders shall be executed in the following manner:

- 5.1. ISR shall, within a period of two (2) months from the effective date of the Agreement (the "**Effective Date**"), issue a Purchase Order for two (2) sets of the Device, which contains 24 units (20 tons), subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement and the Technical Specification.
- 5.2. Additionally, during the Agreement Period and/or the Additional Period, ISR, in its sole discretion, shall have the option (but shall not be obligated) to purchase from the Winning Bidder additional set/s of 24 units each (20 ton), and/or set/s of 4 units each (40 tons) and/or set/s of 4 units (25 tons) (the "**Optional Devices**"). The relevant terms and conditions detailed in this Tender, including its Appendices, shall apply, *mutatis mutandis*, to the Optional Devices.

6. **Warranty**

The Bidder shall provide twenty-four (24) months Warranty Period, commencing from installation and completion of Final Acceptance Tests and additional sixty (60) months as a yearly optional warranty period (the "**Yearly Optional Warranty Period**") for each of the Devices, all as set forth in the Agreement.

7. **Delivery Terms**

The terms of supply and delivery of the Devices shall be as set forth in the Agreement.

8. **Delivery Time**

The Delivery Time for the manufacture and supply of the Devices shall be as set forth in the Agreement.

9. **Selection of the Winning Proposal**

The evaluation of the Proposals submitted by Bidders shall be conducted by ISR in accordance with the following process:

9.1. **Stage A- Past Experience:** Prior to the Bidder's evaluation according to the Stages specified below, ISR shall examine Bidder's past experience, should that exist.

9.1.1. ISR reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to reject any particular Proposal based solely on such past experience, should that experience was negative or unprofitable over the course of the past years, including, but not limited to, dissatisfaction, with the Bidder's performance, breach of contract, suspicion of fraud, unreasonable claims, etc.

9.1.2. In case ISR decides to reject Proposal, the Bidder shall be invited to a hearing, which shall be held by ISR Supreme Tender Committee, in which the Bidder shall have the opportunity to present his claims against such rejection.

9.1.3. Should ISR Supreme Tender Committee decide not to reject the Proposal, ISR shall continue the evaluation of the Bidder in accordance with the stages specified hereinafter.

9.2. **Stage B- Pre-Requisite:** Bidders will be evaluated in accordance with Sections 1 and 2 above.

9.3. **Stage C- Evaluation of the Technical Proposal:** For the removal of doubt, Bidder's Technical Proposal shall comply with the Technical Specifications (**Appendix A**). However, ISR, at its sole discretion, shall have the right to accept slight deviations from certain requirements.

9.3.1. Bidder's Technical Proposals will be scored in accordance with the criteria and evaluation process specified in **Appendix G**.

9.3.2. It is hereby clarified that all values related to the characteristics detailed in **Appendix G**, Technical Evaluation and Scoring, will be specified by the Bidder with supporting proof documentation regarding how the specific value has been determined. The determination may be based on calculations, tests or estimations. In any case, the relevant documentation is to be provided and shall be complete and comprehensible.

9.3.3. All parts, components, documents, drawings and calculations in Bidder's Technical Proposal as well as any document attached thereto shall comply with all instructions and requirements below and with all requirements in the Tender Documents, including for the removal of doubt the Agreement and Technical Specifications.

9.3.4. The maximal technical evaluation and scoring (the “TES”) for the Technical Proposal shall be 30 points.

9.3.5. For clarification, scoring by ISR of the Technical Proposal for the purpose of selection of a Winning Bidder, shall not be construed as approval by ISR of such Technical Proposal, irrespective of the scoring and even if the Technical Proposal is attributed the maximal score, and nothing herein shall derogate from any right of ISR and from any obligation of Bidder under the Agreement and the Tender Documents, including but without limitation in connection with design review.

9.3.6. If (i) the Technical Proposal submitted by Bidder to ISR includes any improvement (in ISR's opinion) to any requirement of Appendix A, (ii) such improvement is approved by ISR at its sole discretion, and (iii) Bidder is selected as the Winning Bidder and enters into the Agreement with ISR, then such improvement shall be deemed included in Bidder's obligations under the Agreement.

9.4. **Stage D– Commercial Evaluation** – After completion of the evaluation and scoring of the Technical Proposals, ISR shall open the Commercial Proposals. The Commercial Proposals will be evaluated as further specified in Appendix B.

9.4.1. After the Total Evaluated Price is determined, the Commercial Proposal scoring of each Proposal will be calculated in accordance with the following formula:

$$\text{CP Scoring} = \frac{\text{LTEP} \times 70}{\text{BTEP}}$$

Where:

CP Scoring – Bidder's Commercial Proposal Scoring

LTEP– Lowest TEP

BTEP– the specific TEP of the Bidder, as specified in Section 9 of Appendix B

9.4.2. The maximal CP Scoring shall be 70 points.

9.5. **Stage E- Selection of the Winning Proposal-** ISR shall select the Winning Proposal after determination of the Proposals receiving the highest Final Score (“FS”) pursuant to the following formula:

$$\text{FS} = \text{TES} + \text{CP}$$

Where : **FS** – Bidder's Final Scoring; **TES** – Bidder's Technical Proposal Scoring; **CP** – Bidder's Commercial Proposal Scoring

The Bidder whose Proposal shall be chosen as the Winning Proposal, shall be referred to as the "Winning Bidder".

- 9.6. It is hereby clarified that ISR reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to conduct visit to the premises of the Bidder whose Proposal has the highest Final Score in order, *inter alia*, to evaluate such Bidder's ability to comply with its undertakings and warranties in this Tender including the Agreement. Such Bidder shall make its best reasonable efforts to accommodate such visit as soon as requested by ISR.
- 9.7. ISR reserves the right, under its sole discretion, to reject and/or disqualify a Proposal in the event the Bidder does not accommodate such visit at all and/or in the time frame required by ISR and/or such visit raises doubts with regards to the accuracy of Bidder's warranties in the Tender and/or the Agreement and/or its ability to comply with its undertakings under this Tender including the Technical Specifications and the Agreement.
- 9.8. **Stage F- Selection of the Standby Bidder-** in addition to the Winning Bidder, ISR shall select a standby bidder, which has received the second-best Final Score (the "**Standby Bidder**").
- 9.9. In the event that ISR for any reason whatsoever does not enter into a contractual relationship with the Winning Bidder, and/or the Agreement with the Winning Bidder is cancelled or terminated, ISR shall be entitled to replace the Winning Bidder with the Standby Bidder. All terms set forth in this Section shall apply, *mutatis mutandis*, following the replacement of the Bidder's proposal as aforesaid.

10. **Price Proposal**

10.1. **Price for the Devices**

The Bidder shall provide its price Proposal for the manufacture and supply of the Devices, including the Optional Devices (collectively the "**Proposed Price for the Devices**"), in the Bidder's Proposal Form attached hereto as **Appendix B**, in accordance with the following instructions:

- 10.1.1. The Proposed Price for the Devices shall include twenty-four (24) months Warranty Period fee, Maintenance fee, Consumables supplied during the Warranty Period, Spare Parts, and Training of ISR's staff.
- 10.1.2. The Proposed Price shall be quoted in the Bidder's Proposal Form in Euro (€), inclusive of all the services and equipment specified herein

and including Warranty Period. The Proposed Price is the final, complete and inclusive price that will be paid to the Winning Bidder for the Devices and the accompanying services to be provided by it. The Winning Bidder shall not be entitled to any other payment, fee or compensation whatsoever from ISR.

- 10.1.3. The Proposed Price shall be fixed and shall not be linked to any price increase mechanism for a period of one (1) year from the Final Submission Date. As from the 1st anniversary of the Final Submission Date, Proposed Price for the Devices shall be linked in accordance with the linkage mechanism established in Appendix B.

10.2. **Price for Optional Yearly Warranty and Maintenance Services:**

- 10.2.1. Bidders shall propose yearly fee for Optional Warranty and Maintenance Period. The Optional Yearly Warranty and Maintenance Period will include the fee for the Warranty Period, Corrective and Preventive Maintenance fee, Spare Parts and Training. The Optional Yearly Warranty Period shall be up to a total of sixty (60) months.
- 10.2.2. The Proposed Prices for the Devices and for the Optional Yearly Warranty and Maintenance shall include any sum which the Israeli Tax Authorities require to be withheld at source. The amounts required by the applicable law to be withheld at source by the Israeli Tax Authorities shall be deducted from all sums set and shall be paid to the Israeli Tax Authorities.

11. **Tender Procedure – General**

11.1. **Download of the Tender Documents**

Tender Documents are available via ISR's website: rail.co.il or via the Electronic Tender Box in the SourcingVision system of "Mashik Ltd.", at the following address:

The Bidder's registration will be carried out through the link available at SourcingVision' system.

11.2. **Submission of Proposals**

- 11.2.1. All Proposals must be submitted to the Electronic Tender Box of Israel Railways at the SourcingVision system, starting **October 5**,

2026, 08:00 (Israel Time) until October 7, 2026, 23:59 (Israel time)
(the **"Final Submission Date"**). After this deadline, it will not be possible to submit Proposals to the Electronic Tender Box.

- 11.2.2. It is emphasized that only Proposals submitted to the Electronic Tender Box by the Final Submission Date will be reviewed by the Tender Committee. Proposals not submitted to the Electronic Tender Box by this deadline will **not** be reviewed and will be considered invalid.
- 11.2.3. For the avoidance of any doubt, it is hereby clarified that the Final Submission Date refers to the last date for submitting the Proposal in the Electronic Tender Box of ISR in the SourcingVision system.
- 11.2.4. Accordingly, Bidders are advised to enter the electronic system in advance and perform all necessary preparations to ensure that the Proposals are submitted on time and to avoid delays due to various technical issues.
- 11.2.5. It is emphasized that ISR and/or Mashik and/or their representatives shall not be responsible in any manner for the proper functioning of the phone and/or internet network and shall not bear any responsibility for interruptions and/or disturbances and/or disconnections that prevent any Bidder from submitting their Proposals on time to the Electronic Tender Box. The Bidder hereby declares that their participation in the Tender is subject to the availability and proper functioning of the internet network and that they shall not raise any claim, lawsuit, or demand against ISR and/or Mashik and/or their representatives due to any mistake, malfunction, delay, technical failure, or any other reason that prevented them from submitting their Proposal on time.
- 11.2.6. The clock of the Electronic Tender Box is the official clock for the submission deadlines in this Tender.
- 11.2.7. The Proposal shall be submitted by a single Bidder. Proposals submitted by more than one Bidder will be disqualified.
- 11.2.8. Each Bidder shall be allowed to submit only one Proposal. Submission of more than one Proposal by the same Bidder, including by a related company of the said Bidder, shall disqualify the Bidder
- 11.2.9. The Bidder is requested to read carefully all the Tender Documents attached herein and submit all documents signed, where applicable, by the authorized signatory bodies.

- 11.2.10. The Bidder must scan the forms attached as Appendices, which have been filled out and signed by him, and upload them to the Electronic Tender Box in the SourcingVision system, in the required location for each Appendix or document, by clicking the "*Submit Documents*" button and in accordance with this Section, no later than the Final Submission Date.
- 11.2.11. It is hereby emphasized that Bidder's responsibility to ensure that the forms that were scanned and uploaded were indeed uploaded to the system and are legible and clear.
- 11.2.12. It is recommended that the Bidder shall retain a copy of the Proposal submitted to the Electronic Tender Box.
- 11.2.13. For any technical assistance regarding the use of the Electronic Tender Box system, the Bidder may contact the support representatives of Mashik Ltd. by email at: service@mashiktech.com, or by phone at +972-50-9029376, from Sunday to Thursday between 08:00 and 17:00 Israel Time (excluding holiday eves and holidays).
- 11.2.14. The Bidder's Proposal shall include the following documents:
- 11.2.14.1. A signed copy of the Technical Specifications (*Appendix A*).
- 11.2.14.2. Operation, maintenance and training instructions in English or in Hebrew (in PDF format) including, *inter alia*, the following:
- 11.2.14.2.1. Installation procedure, including equipment setup;
- 11.2.14.2.2. Operation manual;
- 11.2.14.2.3. Maintenance and troubleshooting;
- 11.2.14.2.4. Drawings and schematics, including those for mounting the Devices;
- 11.2.14.2.5. Special tools and/or equipment;
- 11.2.14.2.6. Spare Parts List;
- 11.2.14.2.7. Any and all drawings, documentation, information and certifications required pursuant to *Appendices A and G*;

- 11.2.14.2.8. A signed and completed Bidder's Proposal Form (**Appendix B**);
- 11.2.14.2.9. A signed copy on the last page of the Agreement (**Appendix C**), including the Bidder's relevant information in the heading thereof (excluding the date) and including the Bank Account Form, attached to the Agreement as **Annex C** (only after the appointment of a Winning Bidder, such Winning Bidder will be required to complete part B of the Bank Account Form).
- 11.2.14.2.10. A signed and completed Experience List (**Appendix D**);
- 11.2.14.2.11. A signed and completed Manufacturer and Supplier Declaration (**Appendix E**);
- 11.2.14.2.12. A signed and completed Spare Parts List (**Appendix F**);
- 11.2.14.2.13. A signed and completed Tender Acceptance Letter (**Appendix H**);
- 11.2.14.2.14. A signed and completed Confidentiality Undertaking (**Appendix I**);
- 11.2.14.2.15. A signed Safety (**Appendix J**).

12. **Proposal Validity**

- 12.1. All submitted Proposals must be valid for a period of twelve (12) months commencing from the Final Submission Date, as set forth above (the "**Proposal Validity Period**"), and may not be revoked or changed by the Bidder during this period for any reason whatsoever.
- 12.2. **Extension of Proposal Validity Period** – Prior to the expiry of the Proposal Validity Period, ISR shall be entitled to request all Bidders, relevant at such time, to extend the date of validity of their Proposals by an additional period, the duration of which will be determined by ISR.
- 12.3. **No Additional Changes** – Extension of the validity date of its Proposal beyond the Proposal's Validity Period shall not entitle the Bidder to change, amend, add or delete any of the contents of its Proposal. Any such change, amendment,

addition or deletion shall entitle ISR, at its sole and absolute discretion, to disqualify the Bidder from any further participation in the Tender.

- 12.4. In the event that ISR for any reason whatsoever does not enter into a contractual relationship with the Winning Bidder and/or the Agreement with the Winning Bidder is cancelled, ISR shall be entitled to elect as a Winning Proposal, the second-best Proposal. The terms set forth in this Section shall apply, *mutatis mutandis*, following the replacement of the Bidder's Proposal as aforesaid.

14. **Confidentiality and Proprietary Rights**

- 14.1. By participating in the Tender process, each Bidder is deemed to have agreed to keep in strict confidence, and not to disclose and/or to make any use of any information or data, or any form or media, partial or complete, provided to them by ISR on its behalf or made known to them otherwise as a result of or in connection with the Tender; except that each Bidder may use such information or data solely for the purpose of preparing its Proposal. It is hereby clarified that this section shall not apply to documents and/or information published by ISR on its website.

- 14.2. By submitting a Proposal, each Bidder shall be deemed to represent and warrant to ISR that (i) it is not bound by any contractual or statutory obligations which would preclude the Bidder from providing the data and information contained in the Proposal or any portion thereof, (ii) it has the right to make all disclosures that are made in the Proposal; (iii) the data and information contained in the Proposal do not include any confidential information, trade

secret or other proprietary information of the Bidder and/or to any third party (except as and to the extent that the Bidder may otherwise clearly indicate in writing) that ISR is prevented from using it.

- 14.3. All rights and titles in and to any and all drawings, sketches, and other technical documents and information provided by ISR or on its behalf to the Bidder as well as to all of the Tender Documents and the contents thereof, shall be deemed to be the sole and exclusive proprietary of ISR, and/or their use by ISR allowed by third parties.

15. **General**

- 15.1. A Proposal reflecting any reservation regarding the Tender Documents or any part thereof, including the Agreement or the Appendices attached thereto, whether by rejection, insertion or amendment to any part of the attached documents, may be disqualified.
- 15.2. ISR shall not be bound to accept the lowest-priced proposal or any other Proposal whatsoever. In addition, ISR does not commit itself in any way to acquire any Devices or to enter into a contractual relationship with any of the Bidders.
- 15.3. ISR shall have the right, at its sole and absolute discretion, to verify the recommendations and other documents provided by the Bidder, and to request from any of the Bidders additional details, approvals, recommendations and/or certificates. In addition, ISR may, at its sole and absolute discretion, upon prior coordination with the Bidder, inspect the facilities of such Bidder at any time or any facilities where components of the Devices proposed by the Bidders are being manufactured.
- 15.4. Any of the Devices acquired shall be on a non-exclusive basis and ISR, at its sole discretion may, at any time, obtain Devices from any of the Bidders, and/or may acquire similar or identical Devices from any third party.
- 15.5. ISR shall issue Purchase Orders under the Agreement following the receipt and subject to the receipt of the necessary budgetary approvals.
- 15.6. ISR, in its sole discretion, may decide not to select any of the submitted Proposals or may decide to cancel the entire Tender at any time.
- 15.7. ISR reserves the right to reject a Proposal of a Bidder which does not have the financial strength required for the performance of the Agreement or that its commercial Proposal is significantly lower than ISR's estimation.

- 15.8. In addition to any other event which entitles ISR by law to cancel the Tender, ISR reserves the right, at ISR's sole discretion, to cancel this Tender in the following events:
- 15.8.1. If only one of the Proposals is found suitable, according to the Prerequisites and/or other specification requirements according to these Tender Documents;
 - 15.8.2. If ISR concludes that there was a flaw in the Tender process and/or in the evaluation of the Proposals;
 - 15.8.3. If ISR has found that a critical mistake has been made in the Technical Specifications, *inter alia*, by giving false data, missing data or incomplete data;
 - 15.8.4. If the circumstances and/or ISR's requirements have been significantly changed, to such extent which requires the cancellation of the Tender.
- 15.9. All documents submitted in this Tender must be in English or Hebrew (including but not limited to all attachments, schedules, annexes, sketches, drawings, diagrams, tables and charts).
- 15.10. Any additional information, questions, requests for clarification and interpretation, or any other communication, must be submitted in writing in English only, unless otherwise approved by ISR.
- 15.11. Each Bidder shall solely bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its Proposal. This shall include, without limitation, any and all expenses and losses, which may be incurred by the Bidder, consultations with professionals, conducting investigations and inquiries of any kind, preparation of surveys and documents and the authentication and translation thereof and any other aspect in connection with the Proposal. ISR will in no case be responsible or liable for any of the above costs, nor shall it be required, under any circumstances, to reimburse any such costs to any Bidder.

16. **Request for clarifications and/or additional information**

- 16.1. Any Bidder may submit to ISR, in writing in English only, inquiries and/or requests for clarification and/or additional information regarding the Tender or relating to the Tender Documents, as specified herein below (a “**Request for Clarification**”).
- 16.2. A Request for Clarification shall clearly specify to which Tender Documents it refers (Agreement, Technical Specification, Appendix, Section, etc.).

16.3. Bidders shall submit Requests for Clarification with respect to any errors, ambiguities, inconsistencies, omissions, erroneous, unclear or imperfect provisions (The "**Errors**") in the Tender Documents. It is clarified that by submitting its Proposal, Bidder irrevocably and unconditionally waives any claim, demand or legal or administrative proceeding alleging or claiming that the selection process in the Tender has been influenced or biased by an Error and/or that Bidder has suffered any damages as a result of such Error.

16.4. ISR, at its sole discretion, may arrange clarification meetings, site visits, conferences or discussions, in Israel, and instruct Bidders that participation is compulsory on all Bidders wishing to submit a Proposal.
